

Snow Day Extended Learning

Music Grade K & 1

If a snow day occurs on a regularly scheduled music day, please spend 20 minutes doing one of the following activities of your choice:

*Music is all around us. We can hear it in the sounds of cars on the road, birds singing in the trees, wind blowing, and footsteps in our house. Make a list of the sounds that you hear throughout the day. Try to list as many sounds as you can. An adult may help you write the words.

*Draw a picture full of the things or people whose sounds you hear. You may do it in pencil or crayon.

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Gr. 3 Music

If you miss a recorder music class due to a snow day, please practice 20 minutes on the following:

*The current assignment in your red lesson book, Sweet Pipes.

*Any songs we have played for ribboning.

You may also include in your practice time, if you wish, trying any other songs in the red song book, Sweet Pipes.

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Gr. 4 Music

If a snow day occurs on our regularly scheduled music day, please spend 20 minutes doing the following:

*Practice any songs in our musical that we have covered so far.

*Listen to the music in our play on Youtube, with parent permission, by typing in the title of the musical and the composer.

Snow Day Extended Learning Gr. 4 Band Program

If a snow day occurs on our regularly scheduled band day, please spend 20 minutes doing any combination of the following:

*Play through #1 and/or #2 on page 42 of our blue lesson book, Accent on Achievement.

*Practice the band music in your folder.

*Practice the 8-note warm up scale going up and down.

*With parent permission, log on to the music company JWPepper.com, type in the title and composer of your band music and listen to professionals play the music.
